Earlier this month, NKS Masters Club members were provided the opportunity to practice traditional Japanese fencing techniques. Brown and Black Belt students and teachers reviewed etiquette, fundamental postures, draws, kata (forms), and partner exchange drills (kumitachi) of Katori Shinto Ryu and Yagiu Shinkage. Students also viewed rare historical footage of Japanese Ken-jutsu and Batto-jutsu masters preparing and cutting tamashiwara.

The workshop culminated in tamashiwara, or “spirit testing techniques”, where each participant demonstrated their cutting prowess.
